——— 55th Annual Middlebury Summer Festival Parade

This year's Middlebury Summer Festival is June 21 and 22, 2024. The Festival is a tradition of the Town of Middlebury, located in the heartland of northern Indiana's Amish Country.

The Parade will happen on June 22 at 1:00 PM, with staging two hours before the start. PLEASE NOTE: The parade check-in location is on the East side of South Main Street (S.R. 13), just north of Orpha Drive (see map on back).

Because of limited turn-around space, Parade Units arrive at the check-in area from the SOUTH (see map).

We will have the check-in area marked, and people will be there to assist you in finding your staging area. We hope this will help reduce the congestion at the Elementary School, making staging stress-free. Thank you for being so helpful in making this year's Parade a success.

The Parade is a marching parade. Any parade units performing before the grandstand will <u>NOT BE JUDGED</u>.

All Parade units will be judged, and awards in the following categories will be given:

- 1) Band / Color Guard/ Drill Team
- 2) Historic/ Classic/ Sport Vehicle

- 3) Organization
- 4) Non-categorical 5) Commercial

Throwing candy from the parade units is not permitted. Feel free to have people distribute the candy along both sides of the streets, but please do not throw it from your entry.

Please return your entry form before June 3, 2024. You may mail, email, or drop off your completed form using one of the options listed below. We will contact you with your parade entry number and staging information the week before the Parade. Please see the reverse side for the map of the staging area. We hope to hear from you and see you on June 22, 2024.


